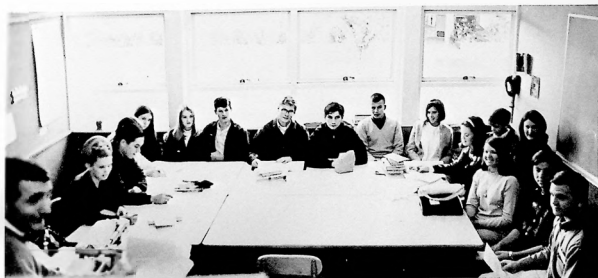

Among I.C.C.'s various activities were two floats and two A.F.S. cars in the Football Festival, and the supervision of door decorations during the Christmas season.

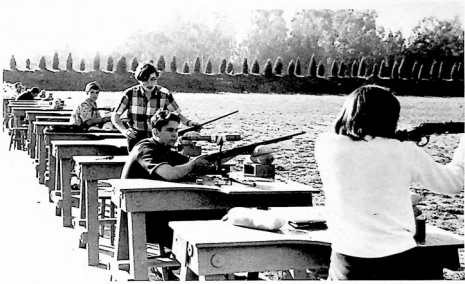


## Rifle Club

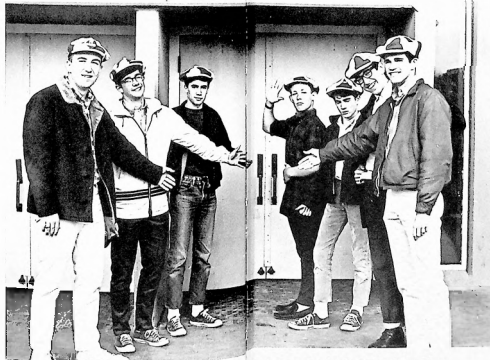

In January 1967, I left New York City with 40 other A.F.S. students. We were all for a year of cultural exchange and study in Brazil. My home was in Corias do Sul, a city of 120,000 people, about 600 miles south of Rio de Janeiro. I lived with the De Corli family, which included my father, a radiologist, my mother, my sister Maria, 21, and my brothers, Alexandre, 20, Guilherme, 15, Jose Inacio, 11. Arriving in Brazil in the summertime, I had a chance to study Portuguese for 1½ months before classes began in March. I attended class from 4-8 P.M., 6 days a week, and my study was in the scientific field. School lasted until November at which time our family traveled to Uruguay, Sao Paulo and we saw much of the Brazilian countryside. The life of the Brazilian is very different from ours. School is not the center of activities as it is here. Friendships and social activities are found in the social clubs and through the family. Maybe one day some of you will travel to Brazil and meet these warm, hospitable people and see their beautiful country.

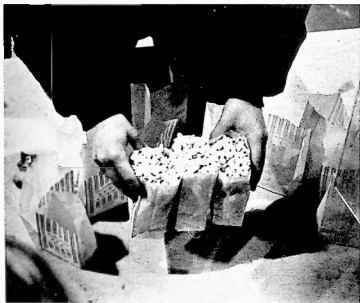
The Timers' Association aids the coaches in making sports events run more smoothly and efficiently.

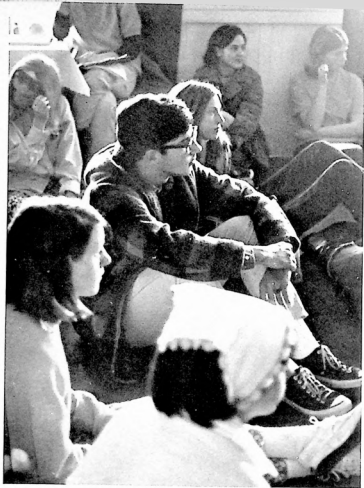
## G.A.A.

Miramonte's fourth annual Football Festival was the termination of weeks of hard work and planning by the classes. The floats represented familiar legends from American and English folklore.

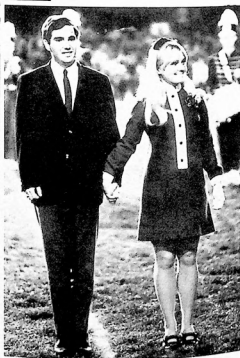

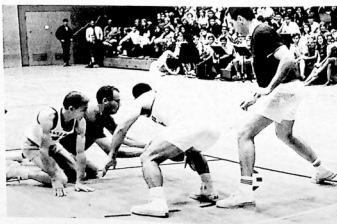


# The McCarthy Scholarship Fund Grows

The Exchange Days must be considered successful, as each school gained an appreciation of its own campus through seeing another school.

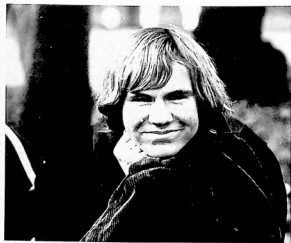


## WELCOME GIRLS' CONFERENCE

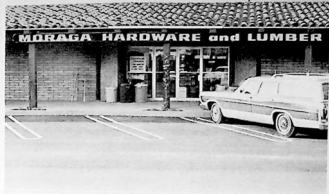
